

STATE COURT RULES: UTCRS AND SLRS

Circuit courts may adopt local rules that govern local practice. These local rules, called Supplementary Local Rules or SLRs, must be consistent with the Uniform Trial Court Rules (UTCrs), the Oregon Rules of Civil Procedure, and state law.

SLRs are effective February 1 each year unless specifically adopted “out-of-cycle.” The SLRs may be found here: <http://www.courts.oregon.gov/rules/Pages/slr.aspx>.

The UTCrs – applicable statewide – are effective August 1 each year unless specifically adopted “out-of-cycle.” The UTCrs may be found at: <http://www.courts.oregon.gov/programs/utcr/Pages/currentrules.aspx>.
